What is EUROGYM?

Eurogym is an international event that brings together young gymnasts from different European countries. It is organized by European Gymnastics (EG) and is held every two years.

Eurogym is not a competition but rather a non-competitive gymnastics festival that focuses on promoting the sport of gymnastics and fostering friendship and cultural exchange between young athletes from different countries. The event typically includes gymnastics performances, workshops, cultural activities, and social events.

Eurogym is open to gymnasts between the ages of 12 and 18 who are members of EG-affiliated national gymnastics federations. The event is hosted by a different European city each time, with the host city responsible for organizing the various activities and providing accommodation and transportation for participants.

Overall, Eurogym is a great opportunity for young gymnasts to develop their skills, make new friends, and experience different cultures while promoting the sport of gymnastics at an international level.


EUROGYM is open to young people aged 12 to 18 years old.


A group that has 10 participants (or more) can include younger participants (10 and/or 11 years old) and older participants (19 and/or 20 years old) according to the table below.

About Norway

Some facts about Norway

- Ca. 5 400 000 inhabitants
- Nearly half of the inhabitants live in the southeastern parts surrounding the capital Oslo
- About two thirds of Norway is mountainous
- The length of the Norwegian coastline is 25 148 km, including fjords
- The highest mountain in Norway is Galdhøpiggen (2 469 masl)
- The world longest road tunnel, Lærdalstunnelen (24.5 km), is situated in the western part of Norway
- The Nobel Peace Prize is awarded in Oslo
- Two official languages Norwegian and Sami
- The Norwegian spoken language has many different dialects varying between the regions

Vikings

The Vikings were fearless seafarers. In the period from about the year 800-1000, they emigrated from Denmark, Norway and Sweden to countries and islands in Europe and North Atlantic. Although today they are best known for their Viking expeditions, they were also traders, explorers and settlers.

Fun facts

- Norway has won more medals in the Winter Olympics than any other country
- Brown Cheese is a staple on Norwegian breakfast and lunch tables (that is caramel-like brown cheese)
- It was a Norwegian who invented the cheese slicer
- The most famous artwork to come out of Norway is Edvard Munch's iconic «The Scream», and once held the Guinness World Record for «the world's most expensive painting» when a version of it (there are 4), was sold for almost \$120 mill. at Sotheby's in 2012
- The North Cape bills itself as the northernmost point in Europe. The settlement is nearer to the North Pole than to Oslo
- In Svalbard, an island 2030 km north of Oslo, 1050 km south of the North Pole it is required by law to be armed when you leave a settlement due to the danger of a polar bear encounter
- The Samis. Half the world's Sami population lives in Norway
- Norway has been named the world's happiest country

Bodø is a compact city and a gateway to a unique assortment of wonderous arctic experiences. With the natural resources around us, we can offer world-class experiences, most of them based in the city or just a short bus or boat ride away.


With a location just north of the Arctic Circle, Bodø has a spectacular light throughout the year. During summer, the midnight sun facinates and captivates us all. In winter and autumn, you will see the mysterious blue that lights up the dark polar night, and the magical and alluring northern lights. With the light as a backdrop for activities, we guarantee unforgettable experiences. The city is famous for its rich and cultural scene, and for being an arctic hub in the North. Bodø also has a resourceful business community, and a university that is committed to collaboration with national and international communities, businesses and industries.

Bodø will be the European Capital of Culture in 2024

This means that Bodø will deliver a magnificent cultural program throughout the whole year, and EUROGYM will be one of the many events that will color the city with the unique shows from all of you. Youth and young people is our number one key priority in the capital of culture year. In addition to being an important part of our current audience and production base, they are the artists, the organizers the audiences and the cultural founders of the future. We want our young people to develop projects and cultural content together with European youth, with their attention on climate, democracy, urbanisation, freedom of expression, diversity, and through a common cultural identity.

The doors of our region, and our hearts, are wide open to Europe!





Attractions

You will find some of Norway's and Europe's most famous attractions in Bodø. Experience the world's strongest tidal current - Saltstraumen. During a six-hour period, 372 million m³ of seawater pass through a 150 m and 31 m deep channel, which creates whirlpools up to 10 m in diameter and 5 m in depth when the current is at its strongest. A couple of hours drive from Bodø, you can experience the Svartisen Glacier - Northern Scandinavia's biggest glacier. This mighty glacier, underground caves, marble formations, steep peaks and waterfalls, all located in the beautiful national park. The Kjerringøy Trading Post, which is beautifully located in a stunningly scenic landscape, is one of Norway's most important cultural heritage monuments from the 19th century. This living museum provides a unique insight into the coastal culture of Northern Norway. Not far from the downtown Bodø, you will find the Norwegian Aviation Museum, the largest such museum in Scandinavia and one of the most modern in Europe. Furthermore, Bodø is home to the largest colony of European sea eagles in the world.

Also, the people living north of the Arctic Circle are very friendly and open-minded. You will find it easy to communicate with the locals, since language skills in general are very good and English is spoken as a second language everywhere.

Getting here and getting around

Getting to Bodø is easy and there are several options. You can travel here by air from the north, south, east or west. The airport is located only 2 km, or a 10-15 minute walk, from the city centre. You can also arrive on the northbound or southbound Hurtigruten (the Norwegian Costal Voyage) and continue your journey by sea in the beautiful region of Nordland by express boat or ferry. You can drive here along the picturesque Kystriksveien (The Costal Route) which is Norway's longest National Scenic Route or arrive by train via the Saltfjellet mountain range where you cross the Arctic Circle. If you arrive by train, our own Polar Express has its final stop in Bodø, which is the northernmost railway terminal in Northern Norway.



Bodø Airport is situated only 2 km away from the city centre, which is a hub to the rest of the region and Nordland County.




Bodø is the end station of the train line from Oslo/ Trondheim. There are several southward-bound local and regional trains from here every day.



Car There are two main roads to drive to Bodø, the E6 (Fv80) and the Coastal Route (Fv17). There are three Norwegian Scenic Routes in Nordland.



Bus and boat It's easy getting from A to B by bus, ferry or express boat. In the summer you can travel with the Travel Pass Nordland. Hurtigruten have daily arrivals.



The theme for EUROGYM 2024 Midsummer Madness

The theme for EUROGYM 2024 is «Midsummer Madness», a celebration of the long summer days and bright nights in the land of the midnight sun. Located above the Arctic Circle, Bodø is a unique and vibrant city that comes alive in the summer months, when the sun never sets.

During the event, participants will experience the magical atmosphere of the midnight sun, with endless daylight and northern Norwegian nature. It is a very special experience to be outside in daylight when sounds and wildlife indicate that it is night. The midnight sun will provide a unique backdrop for a variety of sports and cultural activities, including music, dance, and gymnastic performances.

The midnight sun is a natural phenomenon that occurs when the sun remains visible at midnight. This phenomenon is particularly pronounced in the Arctic regions, including Bodø, where the sun remains above the horizon for over 70 days during the summer months. This creates a unique and magical atmosphere, where the sun never sets, and the days seem to stretch on forever.

Overall, EUROGYM 2024's «Midsummer Madness» theme celebrates the unique and vibrant culture of the region and the magical atmosphere created by the midnight sun. Main Venue

The Main Venue will be in Stormen Concert Hall. This will be the arena for accreditation and infodesk. One of the stages for City Performances will also be here.

This will also be the arena for HOD-meetings and receptions.



EUROGYM Gala will take place in Bodøhallen july 18th. The performance area will be 20x20m, and the roller mats will be 14x20m in blue colour.

As the venue seats 2.100 people at once, we will put up two Gala shows. Audience will be seated on three sides of the venue. Group 1 will start with the Gala and then go for dinner. Group 2 will start with dinner and then go for the Gala. When Gala show number 2 is finished Group 1 will join Group 2 in Nordlandshallen for the Closing ceremony.

The theme for the Gala show is Midsummer Madness. Find information about registration for the Gala below in the Bulletin.

Opening and Closing Ceremony

The parade for the Opening Ceremony will be through the streets of Bodø, and will end at Nordlandshallen with an exceptional Opening Ceremony for EUROGYM 2024.

The Closing Ceremony will also take place in Nordlandshallen, and will be followed by a unforgettable farewell party.

City Performances




The city performances will take place in Stormen Concert Hall, Bodøhallen and Nordlandshallen, and give the groups the opportunity to show what they have prepared at home. All performance levels are acceptable and everybody can participate. Each group will present their performance twice during the week. A group has to consist of minimum 6 gymnasts, and each performance can last a maximum of 6 minutes, including preparation of the venue and marching in and out.

Participants can visit the stages in the morning, but there will be no opportunity for rehearsals at the stages before the city performances.





Her background comes from teamgym as a gymnast and coach with experience from National, Nordic and European Championships. Also, Gry was the artistic director and choreographer for Nordic Evening 2019 (World Gymnaestrada) and World Gym for Life Challenge 2017.

Accommodation

Hotels and schools

The participants will be accommodated in schools near the city center. Even though Bodø is a very safe city, all the schools will have 24-hour security. The schools will be cleaned every day. It will be possible to buy mattresses - more information and prices will be provided in Bulletin no. 2

Each HoD is responsible for the conditions of the school where their groups stay. It is forbidden to consume alcohol and drugs in schools grounds. Not following the rules will have consequences. The accreditation card will be withdrawn and the Head of Delegation is then responsible for finding a hotel room or the first flight home for the person not following the rules.





Registration

Notification of interest May 1st - July 13th 2023

For the notification of interest we will ask for estimated amount of participants from each Federation.

Provisional registration July 13th — November 13th 2023

For the provisional registration we will ask for how many groups that will attend from each Federation, and how many participants there will be in each group. 10% of the participation card should be paid by December 13th, this is non-refundable.

Definitive registration November 13th 2023 — March 13th 2024

For the definitive registration will LOC ask for a lot of details about the participants (personal but not sensitive information), travel plans, special food diet etc.

Registration to perform at the EG Gala

Groups who would like to be in the Gala can apply through their National Federation (European Gymnastics will provide the NF's with an application form). There is no limit to how many applications each federation can send. The maximum duration of one Gala-performance is 3 minutes. Members of the European Gymnastics TC-GFA will choose the groups. LOC choreographer will script the show.

Each performance will be evaluated by the TC-GFA according to the following criteria:

- Entertainment value and overall impression
- Innovation and originality
- Technique, quality and safety
- Variety and diversity

More specific information about this application will be sent to the National Federations in a due time.

Prices

The fee for EUROGYM is 310 EURO The fee for European Gym For Life Challenge is 160 EURO The fee for both EG and EGFL is 410 EURO

Included in the EUROGYM accreditaion card:

- School accommodation from Saturday to Friday (6 nights)
- Breakfast from Sunday to Friday
- Lunch and dinner Sunday to Thursday
- Entry to all ceremonies
- Participation in 4 workshops
- Two performances per team
- FunZone
- Transportation from/to workshops/arenas if needed

Shuttle to/from airport is not included and will be an additional cost. Price for airport shuttle will be announced in Bulletin no. 2.

Deadlines and payment

- 10% of the participation card should be paid by December 13th, this is non-refundable.
- The remaining 90% for the participation should be fully payed by April 13th. Refundable by 50% until May 13th 2024.

Insurance

It is each participant's responsibility to have travel insurance and health and medical care insurance. This needs to be confirmed in the registration. For those who do not have insurance, it will be available through the LOC for a fee. More information about insurance will be announced in Bulletin 2.

Orientation meeting for all Heads of Delegation, Group Leaders and Gala coaches


Sunday July 14th

The LOC and European Gymnastics provide important information during this meeting.

It is mandatory for all Heads of Delegation/Team Leaders of the federations to attend. Unjustified failure to attend will result in a sanction against the federation of € 500.- payable to European Gymnastics. The orientation meeting will take place at Stormen Concert Hall.

Daily meetings with the Heads of Delegation

The participation of the Heads of Delegation is mandatory. Unjustified failure to attend will result in a sanction against the federation of a fine of € 250.-/per meeting payable to European Gymnastics. The daily meetings will take place at Stormen Concert Hall.
